Dept. of Transportation to improve Merrimon Avenue; need for traffic calming devises on Kimberly Avenue; request for update on Edgewood Road re-design; Unified Development Ordinance amendment relative to duplexes, triplexes and quadraplexes in single-family zoning districts and standards for those uses; is there an operation clean sweep in the Police Department; how are grants used by the Police Department; is there an excess of police cars; size of Police Department budget; what is Police Department's policy on videotaping citizens; need for more enforcement of large trucks travelling on Kimberly Avenue, which is prohibited; is Weaver Boulevard on the list for traffic calming devices; what is the noise ordinance in the City and does it apply to UNC-Asheville; request for assistance from City in getting a natural gas line; request for sidewalk repair on Merrimon Avenue sidewalk that leads onto greenway; and need to fix our infrastructure and traffic problems before further development of the City.
